Confession of Sin

A Prayer of Confession and Repentance

I confess that I have not kept Your commandments as I ought. I have been disobedient, rebellious, and self-willed. I have pursued my own interests and desires, rather than seeking Your will and Your way. I have grieved Your Holy Spirit by my sinfulness and unbelief.

Lord, I am sorry for my sins, and I ask for Your forgiveness and cleansing. I plead the blood of Jesus Christ, Your Son, over my life, and I ask that You would wash me and make me clean. Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.

Help me to turn away from my sins, to hate what is evil, and to cling to what is good. Help me to walk in the light as You are in the light, and to have fellowship with You and with my brothers and sisters in Christ.

Confession of Sin and Brokenness

I cling to the promise of Your Word that if I confess my sins, You are faithful and just to forgive me and cleanse me from all unrighteousness.

Father, I ask that You would forgive me and renew a right spirit within me. Help me to turn away from my sin and to walk in Your ways. Remove every hindrance and obstacle that prevents me from

following You with all my heart, soul, mind, and strength. Give me a broken and contrite heart, O God, and a willingness to repent of my sin and turn to You.

May the blood of Jesus Christ cleanse me from all my sin, and may Your Holy Spirit empower me to live a life that honors and glorifies You. May my heart be filled with gratitude for Your grace and mercy, and may I never take for granted the price that was paid for my salvation.

Scripture verse: "For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast." Ephesians 2:8-9

A Prayer for God's Mercy and Restoration

Heavenly Father, we come before you today humbly and with contrite hearts, acknowledging our constant need for your mercy and grace. Confession of Sin and Dependence on God

May Your Holy Spirit empower me to live a life that is pleasing to You, and may I be a witness to Your grace and love in this world. I pray that my life would be a living sacrifice to You, and that You would be glorified in all that I say and do.

Prayer for Repentance and Submission
